


Companion planting with strawberries – your planting plan


Companion planting is helpful for resilient and healthy strawberries. A wide range of biodiversity in the bed reduces the risk of diseases or pest infestations. However, it is important to choose neighbouring plants in such a way that they strengthen the strawberry plants.


In this digital garden plan you will find an example of a year-round mixed crop with strawberries. They grow together with onions, carrots, garlic and lettuce in the bed.

Onions are said to keep numerous pests such as slugs and aphids away from strawberries with their strong scent. Onions are also said to prevent fungal diseases.
